Good evening, and welcome back to The Arena as we kick off our Essex Senior Cup campaign. Our visitors tonight are Brightlingsea Regent of the Isthmian League North division.

The Blues head into tonight's cup tie on the back of a 2-1 victory against Ramsgate at the weekend. Goals from Alejandro Machado and Louie Johnson secured all three points for Keith Rowland's side.

Last season's Essex Senior Cup campaign ended in defeat on penalties away to Witham Town in the Third Round. The game was decided on spot kicks following a 2-2 draw in normal time, with the hosts levelling the scores in stoppage time.

Tonight will provide an opportunity for some of our younger talents to get a taste of first team football, with as many as six of our Under 23s expected to be involved this evening. We are excited to see some of our future Blues getting their opportunity, which highlights the club's ethos of providing young players with a pathway to the first team.

Regent come into this evening's fixture on the back of a 3-0 victory against Walthamstow, and will no doubt be looking to go far in the competition. They reached the Quarter Finals last season, going out on penalties to eventual winners Canvey Island.

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MEET THE TEAM



1 – Melvin Minter – Goalkeeper

Melvin signed for Brentwood Town from Bowers & Pitsea in January 2023. He started his football journey with Oxford United and Brentford. He has played for a variety of Step 1 & 2 clubs such as Chesterfield, Harrogate Town, Kings Langley, Darlington and Concord Rangers. Melvin was part of our 2024/25 title winning side, keeping 17 clean sheets in the league.

5 – Matt Cripps (C) – Defender

Matt joined Brentwood Town in June 2020 from Brightlingsea Regent where he led them as captain to a 103 point Isthmian North league title. Since joining us he has led the club, in 4 full seasons, he has taken us to two Isthmian North play off finals, narrowly missing out on penalties both times, the Third Round Proper of the F.A. Trophy, the furthest the club has been in the tournament to date and the 2024/25 Isthmian North title. A true leader and exceptional captain.



2 – Jon Nzengo – Defender

The right back joined Brentwood Town from Aveley in November 2023, where he also played under current manager Keith Rowland and made over 120 appearances. Nzengo has also played for Romford and East Thurrock United. Since joining in November 2023, Nzengo has established himself as a first team regular. A key part of our title winning side in 2024/25, only missing 4 games in league and cup competitions.

6 – Aron Pollock – Defender

Aron signed for Brentwood Town in June 2025 from Isthmian Premier side Billericay Town. He started his football career with Leyton Orient where he ended up making 11 senior appearances including a Man of the Match award on his debut. Aron had loan spells whilst at Orient with Leatherhead and Wealdstone before signing for Concord Rangers, making over 100 appearances including the F.A. Trophy final at Wembley.



4 – Romel Aarons Royal – Defender

Romel joined Brentwood Town in September 2023 from Welling United. He started his football career playing in the academies of Watford and Charlton Athletic. The towering centre back Aarons Royal went on to establish himself as a regular starter during the title winning season of 2024/25 making 43 appearances in all competitions even coming up with 3 goals, including a last minute winner vs Cray Valley PM in the FA Trophy.

23 – Max Hudson – Defender

Max joined Brentwood Town in the summer of 2025 following promotion to the Isthmian Premier, from fellow Premier outfit Dulwich Hamlet. Hudson began his footballing journey in the youth systems of Tottenham Hotspur and Ipswich Town before signing for Concord Rangers in the National South. Max has also played for Hertford Town and Hayes & Yeading in his time.





15 – Andy Freeman – Defender/Midfielder

Andy came through the youth system and Under 21 teams at Brentwood Town and established himself in the First Team by the end of the 2014/15 promotion winning season. He won the player of the year award in 2015/16 and then again in 2022/23, after his return to the club at the start of the 2019/20 season. A vital part of our title winning side in 2024/25, missing only 2 games in all competitions. A true fan favourite and great servant to the football club.

3 – Wyan Reid – Defender/Midfielder

Wyan re-joined Brentwood in the summer of 2025 for another stint with the club ahead of our return to the Isthmian Premier Division. Being able to play in any position on the right of the field, he is a welcome addition to the side bringing strength and depth in all areas. Reid has played for a handful of clubs around the south east including Aveley, Cheshunt, Hornchurch and a spell in the National South with Concord Rangers.



16 – Charlie Edwards – Midfielder

Charlie joined Brentwood Town in June 2025 from fellow Isthmian Premier outfit Cray Wanderers. Last season with The Wands, he made 31 appearances and scored 3 times. Prior to this, the midfielder spent two seasons with Canvey Island appearing 64 times and scoring 8 goals. Along the way he has also played for Hertford Town, Waltham Abbey, Wingate & Finchley and Potters Bar Town.

12 – Lee Noble – Midfielder

Lee returned to the club where he started his non-league career in 2006 at the start of the 2024/25 season. During his time away, he spent 12 years at Dartford becoming their 6th highest appearance holder of all time playing 489 games. With Dartford he won promotion to the National League South and the National League. More recently, he has played for Tilbury and Heybridge Swifts. A hardworking and experienced midfielder who was a key figure in the centre of the park during the 2024/25 title winning season.



18 – Ade Cole – Midfielder

Ade signed for Brentwood Town in January 2025 from Walthamstow. The midfielder brought a wealth of experience to The Brentwood Arena halfway through season becoming a regular starter and massive part of the 2024/25 title winning side. Ade previously also played for Folkestone Invicta, Braintree Town Hemel Hempstead and Billericay Town.

8 – Shad Ngandu – Midfielder

Shad re-joined Brentwood Town in October 2023 after spells at Aveley, Hythe Town, Maldon & Tiptree and Great Waking Rovers. The midfielder came through our academy system and was a key part of our promotion winning side in 2014/15 to the Isthmian Premier. A creative attacking midfielder who knows where the goal is, proves to be a fan favourite everywhere he has played. Shad was a big part of the 2024/25 side that won the 2024/25 title, amassing 32 appearances despite a lengthy injury sustained away at Hereford in the F.A. Trophy.





19 – Louie Johnson – Midfielder

Louie joined Brentwood Town in May 2025 from Isthmian North side Walthamstow following a very successful season with them. He was Walthamstow's top goalscorer in 2024/25 whilst also taking home their Manager's, Supporters', Player's and Young Player of The Season awards. Louie began his senior football career with Enfield F.C. and has also played for Redbridge, Bedford Town and Bishops Stortford in his career.

20 – Marlon Agyakwa – Midfielder

Marlon returned to Brentwood Town during the 2023/24 campaign. A hardworking and skilful midfielder who played an integral part in the midfield of the 2024/25 title winning season. Agyakwa is a product of the Southend United academy set up and has also played for Canvey Island, Aveley and Stowmarket Town, amongst others.



7 – Sam Park – Midfielder

Sam returned to the club from Heybridge Swifts in June 2024. Park started his career with Brentwood from a young age, rising through the youth system at the club, making his first team debut in 2019. He would go on to make 34 appearances, scoring two goals, before departing for the Swifts in February 2023. During his time at Heybridge, Park was a vital player across their cup qualifying rounds. Park made a handful of appearances and scored once in the 2024/25 season, a campaign sadly hampered by injuries.

24 – Alejandro Machado – Midfielder

Midfielder Alejandro signed for Brentwood Town in October 2025 from fellow Isthmian Premier outlet Aveley. The Spanish born midfielder began his footballing journey with none other than Real Madrid. The Spaniard spent 6 years with the club before moving to England where he has played for a handful of clubs in the English football pyramid, including Woodford Town, South Park Reigate, Guiseley AFC, Basildon United and Grays Athletic.



17 – Jesse Olukulu – Forward

Jesse joined Brentwood Town during the 2023/24 campaign from local side Grays Athletic. He is a quick, creative and skilful winger always causing issues for fullbacks. The young winger has also played for other local teams, Romford and East Thurrock United. Olukulu was our third highest goalscorer in the title winning season of 2024/25 scoring 8 goals and providing 11 assists from 44 appearances.

14 – Manny Ogunrinde – Forward

Manny joined Brentwood Town in May 2025 from fellow Isthmian Premier outfit Aveley where he spent 5 years with the club making 130 appearances and securing back to back promotions from the Isthmian North to the National South. He was awarded the club's Young Player of the Season in Aveley's debut year in Step 2. Manny started his senior career with a two year deal at Salford City, part of the first cohort of the Academy '92.



21 – Kymani Thomas – Forward

Kymani joined Brentwood Town in June 2025 from Isthmian North side Waltham Abbey. During his time at Capershots he contributed 11 league goals. The winger began his footballing career at Dulwich Hamlet and Beckenham Town before moving to Herne Bay where he found the net 10 times in 29 appearances. He has also had spells with Walthamstow and National South side Ebbsfleet United.



10 – Daniel Ogunleye – Forward

Forward Daniel began his footballing journey in the youth system of Brentwood Town before becoming part of the first team set up. Daniel's true breakthrough season came in 2024/25 when given the chance to lead the line, he bagged 43 goals and 13 assists in all competitions for the Blues, bagging himself the Golden Boot and a place in the Isthmian North TOTS. Ogunleye played a vital part in the 2024/25 title winning campaign, scoring goals at some of the most crucial times.

11 – Benas Vaivada – Forward

Benas joined Brentwood Town from Bowers & Pitsea in the summer of 2024 following their promotion from the Isthmian North. Vaivada achieved back-to-back promotion success by featuring in the Aveley squad that won the Isthmian Premier Play-Offs in 2022/23, as the Millers were promoted to the National League South. Benas added to his promotion success making it three consecutive promotions as an integral part of our 2024/25 title winning scoring 15 goals and 13 assists.



22 – Charlee Hughes – Forward

Striker Charlee signed for Brentwood Town from Aveley in June 2025 for his second stint at the club, following promotion to the Isthmian Premier. Charlee began his footballing journey at the academy of Football League club Leyton Orient. He has played for a number of clubs between Steps 4 and 1 including Wealdstone, Hemel Hempstead and Maldon & Tiptree. Charlee also managed two Isthmian North Golden Boot awards in back to back seasons with Brentwood Town and Maldon & Tiptree.





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MEET THE STAFF



Keith Rowland – First Team Manager

Keith enjoyed a distinguished professional playing career as a defender, featuring for clubs such as AFC Bournemouth, West Ham Utd and Queens Park Rangers. Internationally, Rowland earned 19 caps for Northern Ireland between 1993 and 1999, scoring once in a UEFA Euro 2000 qualifying match against Finland.

Transitioning into coaching, Rowland began at Aveley, helping lead them to the Isthmian Premier League playoffs. He then served as assistant manager at Braintree Town under Alan Devonshire. He then became manager of Wingate & Finchley where he achieved two club record high league finishes over three successful seasons.

Keith joined Brentwood in October 2023 and led us to the Isthmian North Play Off final in his first season, narrowly missing out on promotion after losing on penalties to Bowers & Pitsea after beating Bury Town 1-3 away in the semi-final. The season of 2024/25 saw Keith's first full season in charge of the Blues, where he guided the club to a club record Third Round of the F.A. Trophy and to the Isthmian North title for the first time in the club's history.

Steve Butterworth – Assistant Manager

Steve joined us in October 2023 as part of Keith Rowland's coaching team. He joined us with a wealth of experience from his playing career spending a lot of his time in Step 1 and 2 with many teams including Chelmsford City, Dartford and Newport County.



Steve played for Brentwood Town under Steve Witherspoon during his first stint as manager. He retired from playing in January 2019 from Great Wakering Rovers and took the step into management becoming their manager. Before eventually moving onto Romford and East Thurrock United.



John Witham – Goalkeeping Coach

John joined Keith's backroom team as goalkeeping coach in the summer of 2025 from Aveley, where he had been since 2019. He links up with Keith Rowland once again, having worked with him previously at Parkside. Prior to his spell at Aveley, John was involved in the coaching setup at Sawbridgeworth Town.

Alex Akrofi – Attacking Coach

Alex started his football career at Brentwood Town in 2013 and scored a hat-trick in the 2014/15 Play Off Final when we were promoted to the Isthmian Premier. He then moved on to Maidstone United and Tonbridge Angels where he achieved promotion with both clubs in separate seasons into the Conference South before achieving another promotion with Aveley into the Isthmian Premier before finally finishing up his playing career at Tilbury in January 2025 and joining us as a coach the same month.



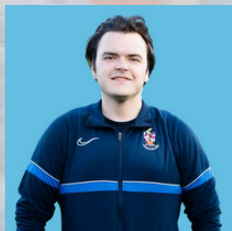
Steve Patient – First Team Physiotherapist

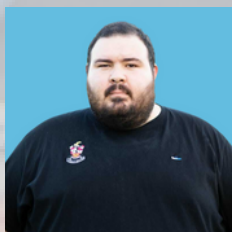
Tommy Morgan – First Team Coach

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MATCH REPORT VS RAMSGATE



Brentwood Town 2-1 Ramsgate Saturday 18th October 2025 Isthmian Premier Division

Louie Johnson's spectacular 75th minute goal proved decisive as league leaders Brentwood got back to winning ways. Despite having a healthy lead at the top of the league, Blues went into the match having dropped points in their previous two matches, but they have showed they are serious title contenders and now have a six-point lead at the top of the Isthmian Premier League table.

The home side had the edge in the early stages and took a tenth minute lead through Alejandro Machedo's diving header at the far post from Andrew Freeman's left wing cross. The Blues could have increased the lead ten minutes later when Daniel Ogunleye broke down the right and crossed to the far post where Freeman's header was cleared off the line.

But the Rams were soon level when Alfie Paxman converted from the penalty spot, and they went close to taking the lead from Billy Munday's header from a corner.

Minter and Prall were both busy again before Johnson's solo run took him through three defenders and fired into the corner goal from the edge of the area.
